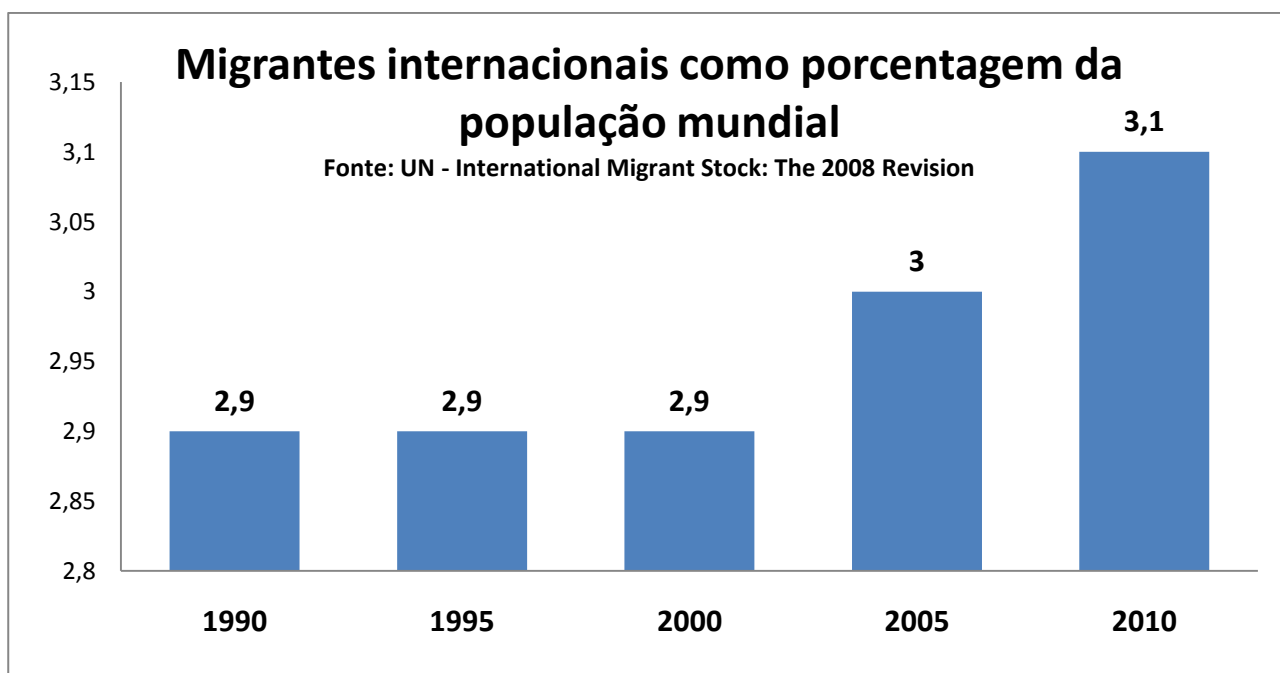
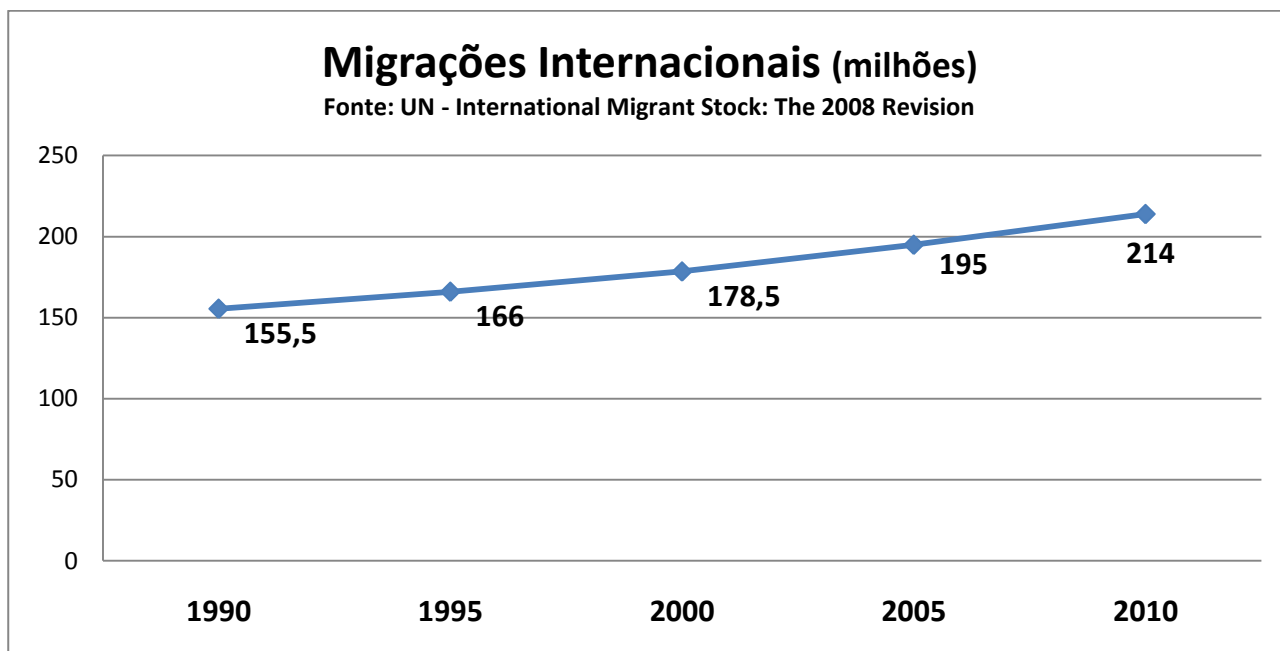


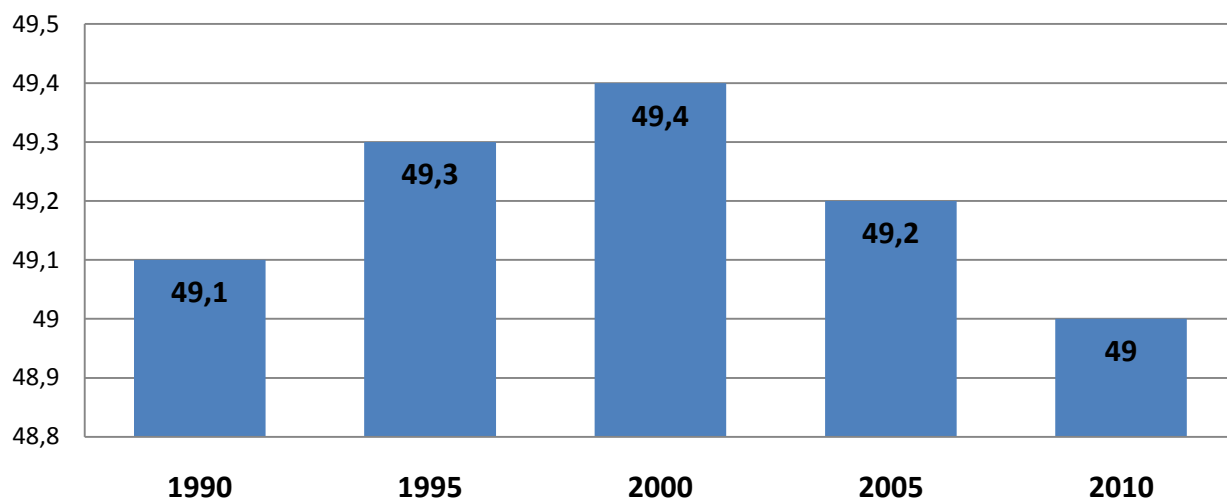
## ESTIMATIVAS DE FLUXOS MIGRATÓRIOS INTERNACIONAIS - 1990/2010

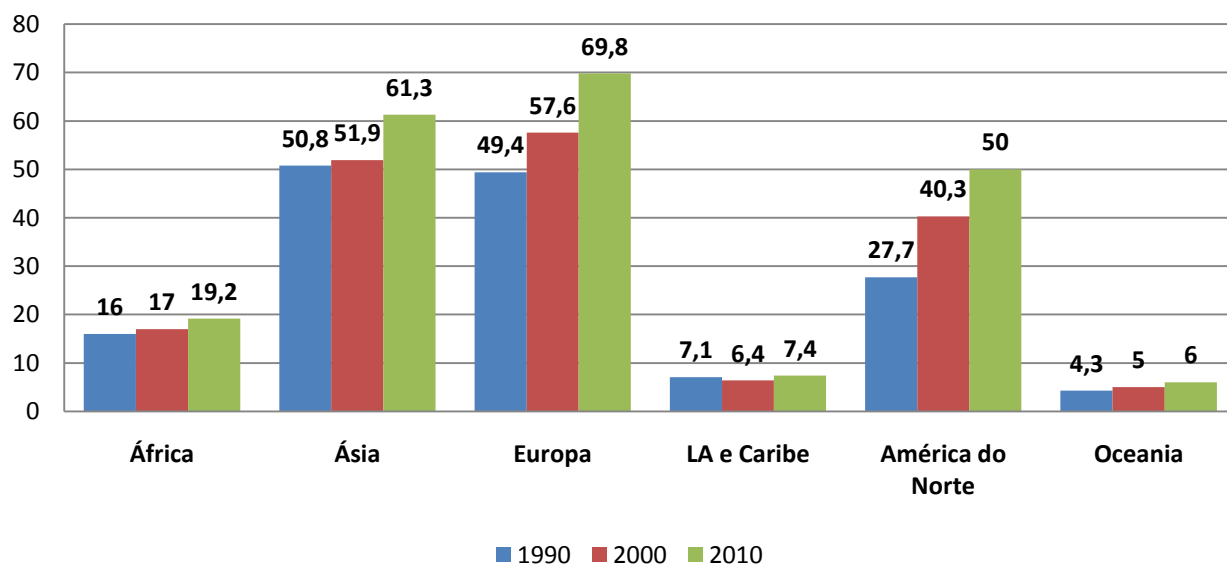
## Porcentagem de mulheres sobre o total de migrantes internacionais

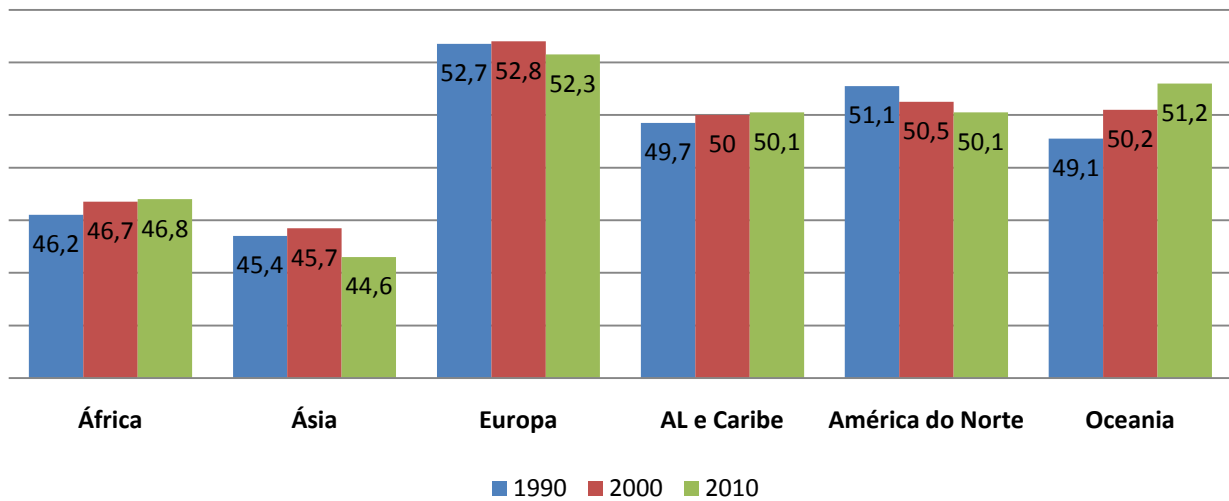
## Migrantes internacionais por área geográfica (milhões)

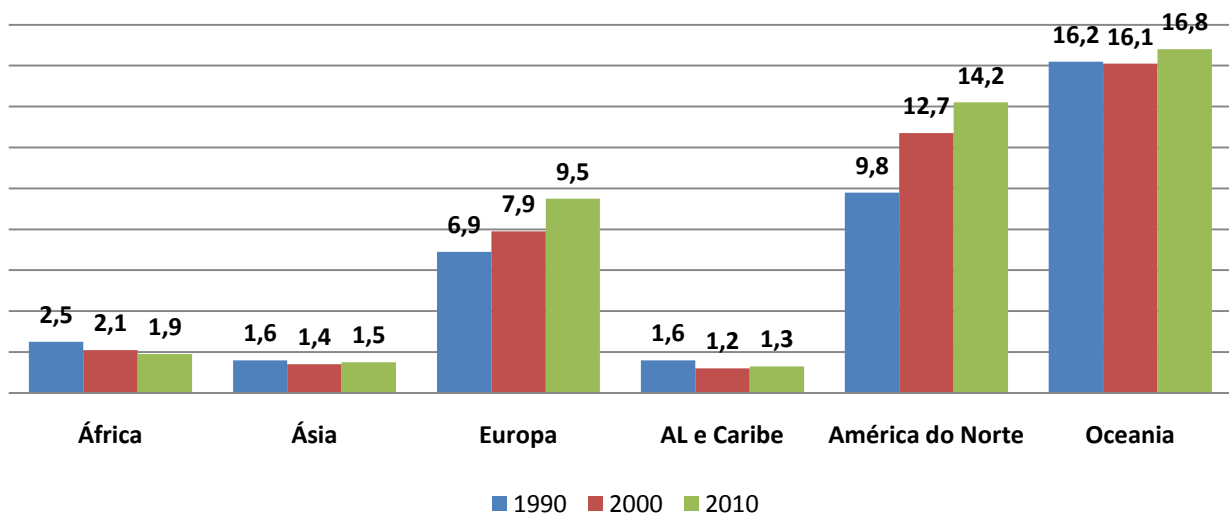
## Porcentagem de mulheres sobre o total de migrantes internacionais por área geográfica

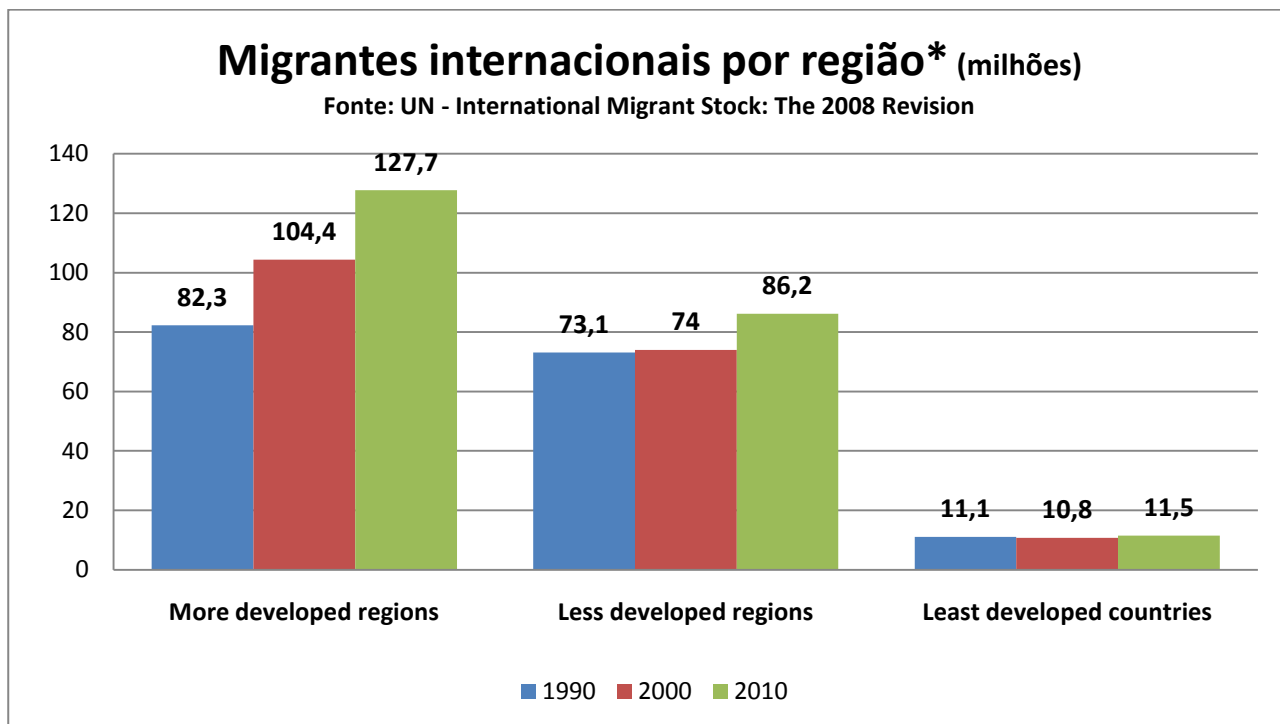

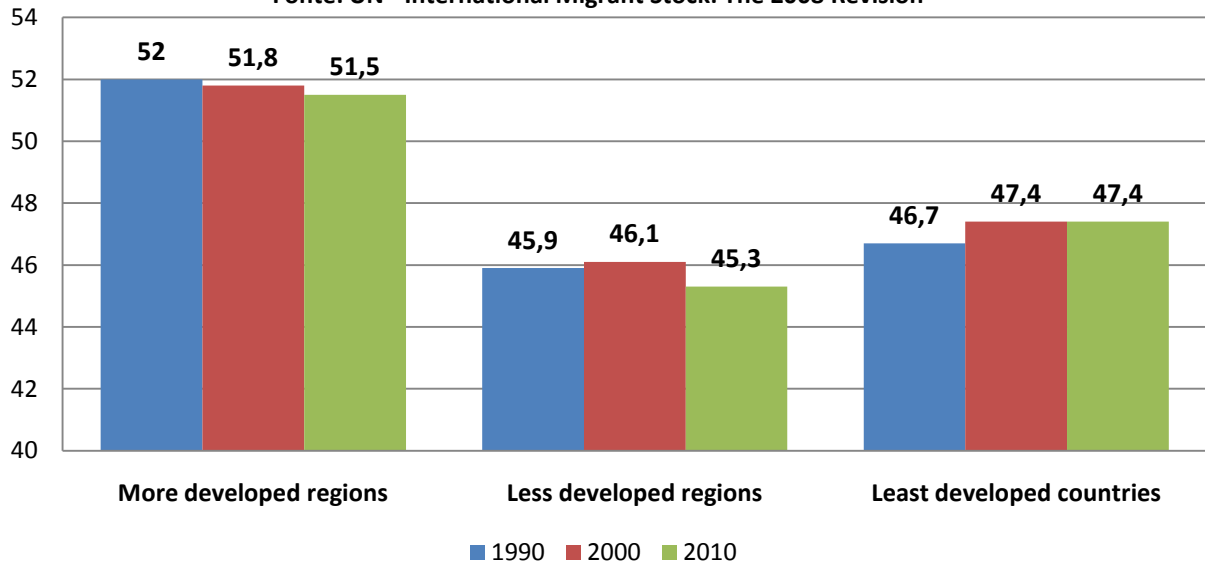
**\*More developed regions:** The more developed regions comprise Australia, Europe, Japan, New Zealand and Northern America.

**Least developed countries:** The group of least developed countries currently comprises 49 countries - Afghanistan, Angola, Bangladesh, Benin, Bhutan, Burkina Faso, Burundi, Cambodia, Central African Republic, Chad, Comoros, Democratic Republic of the Congo, Djibouti, Equatorial Guinea, Eritrea, Ethiopia, Gambia, Guinea, Guinea-Bissau, Haiti, Kiribati, Lao People's Democratic Republic, Lesotho, Liberia, Madagascar, Malawi, Maldives, Mali, Mauritania, Mozambique, Myanmar, Nepal, Niger, Rwanda, Samoa, Sao Tome and Principe, Senegal, Sierra Leone, Solomon Islands, Somalia, Sudan, Timor-Leste, Togo, Tuvalu, Uganda, United Republic of Tanzania, Vanuatu, Yemen, Zambia.
